**"Cows & farmers connected in a landscape of dilemmas" :Thesis presentation by Shosha Raymond**

Shosha Raymond Katzenelson is Master of Arts in Social Psychology and Learning from Roskilde University and a writer of fiction.

She will give a talk on her master’s thesis, that explores the relations between cows and Danish farmers in conventional dairy production in Denmark. In her presentation, she will share insights from her fieldwork, where she employed the method ‘Rubber Boots Methods for the Anthropocene – Doing Fieldwork in Multispecies Worlds’. You will meet the farmers Carl and Mille, as well as the cows 3688 and 3573, on the conventional farm Bakkegården in Jutland. In addition to them, you’ll also hear about milking robots, calves, ghosts, monsters, and monster-managers, and be introduced to a selection of the thesis’s analytical findings.

There will be good time for discussion of relevant methods and theory after her talk and everybody is welcome.

Title and scope: Bildung in the Anthropocene – how to make educational and (post)humanistic research on Education, Culture, and Bildung in an Anthropocene age?

Focus: Critically examination of new research theories, approaches, methodologies, concepts, and research strategies applied in the context of educational research and/or environmental humanities, such as eco-phenomenology, eco-feminism, posthuman, post-qualitative, post-colonial, multispecies and more-than-human research strategies,

and frameworks, including several turns such as the reparative, regenerative, affective, playful, material, and plant-based turn.

Central activities during the 4-day seminar: Conversations and presentations, including keynotes, workshops, and activities outside, good time for Ph.D.-students to present and get their research projects discussed in smaller groups together with senior researchers, as well as text seminars on selected key texts within the syllabus.
